“Prior to being permitted to participate in live fire training evolutions, the student shall have received training to meet the job performance requirements for Fire Fighter I in NFPA 1001, *Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications*, related to the following subjects: (1) Safety; (2) Fire Behavior; (3) Portable Extinguishers; (4) Personal Protective Equipment; (5) Ladders; (6) Fire Hose, Appliances, and Streams; (7) Overhaul; (8) Water Supply; (9) Ventilation; and (10) Forcible Entry.”
