Fall Withdrawal Dates

The last date to withdraw for **4-week** classes would be at the end of the third week of each class (the sixth meeting since 4-week classes generally meet twice a week).

September 25:

Last date to withdraw for first 8-week classes

November 13:

Last date to withdraw for all 16-week classes

November 23:

Last date to withdraw for second 8-week classes
