**POLICY
5.2.6**

- A. A student is considered to be making unsatisfactory academic progress and will be placed on academic probation when his/her cumulative grade point average falls below 2.0 after a designated number of attempted hours.
- B. Such students will be placed on academic probation and will be subject to prescribed steps of intervention to enhance their academic standing and get back on track for progression and graduation.
- C. A student on academic probation will be required to consult (in person or via phone for distance learning students) with a specified academic advisor before registering for another semester. Until that consultation is complete, the student will have a registration hold placed upon his or her record.
