Position: Diagnostic Medical Sonography Instructor

Basic Purpose of Position:

Under the supervision of the Chief of Staff/Vice President for Teaching and Learning, the Medical Sonography Instructor is responsible for teaching duties and other related institutional activities. The Instructor will effectively communicate with students, college personnel, community partners and the public in order to promote the program.

Qualifications:

- Associate's degree required
- Registered Diagnostic Medical Sonographer (RDMS) credential required.
- Two years teaching experience in a community college setting is preferred.

Job Description/Duties:

- Facilitate the creation of a new medical sonography program and its admission process.
- Plan, organize, and develop each course taught in accordance with the academic standards of the Medical Sonography Program.
- Maintain course outlines and objectives for each course, and facilitate the use of innovative methods, equipment and materials that simulate real-world scenarios.
- Coordinate clinical experiences for students of the program.
- Serve as a faculty advisor on designated registration days.
- Participate in a continuous program of curriculum evaluation.
- Assist in developing program budgets for supplies and equipment and submit requisition information for the administration to order these items.
- Assess and evaluate individual student learning outcomes including technical skills and abilities in the classroom, lab, and clinical settings. Maintain accurate records and provide continuous feedback regarding academic progress.
- Promote retention by assisting students to develop strategies for success.
- Provide all class records/grades to the Registrar and to the Records and Reporting Specialist.
- Participate in continuing professional education and activities related to the field of study.
